CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Fire resources continue to aggressively fight the River and Ranch fires. High temperatures and low relative humidity driven by windy conditions contributed to rapid fire spread throughout the day and into the night. Residents are reminded to heed all evacuation notices. Additional resources are enroute to the incident.	
Evacuations Warning:	Mandatory Evacuations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 8000 block of River Road, South to the intersection of Highway 175 from the Russian River east to the Ridge above Highway 175, within the North South points. These evacuations also include all driveways and homes located between the North South points. 	Evacuation Advisories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blue Lakes Bachelor Valley Witter Springs North Scotts Valley Road from the 7000 block to Highway 20 Highway 20 from the 6000 block to the Lake County line and into the Blue Lakes area.

Road Closures:	NONE- Use caution on Highway 20 and Highway 175 - watch for emergency vehicles entering and exiting the roadway.
